Section 22.1-92, *Code of Virginia*, requires school divisions to prepare and distribute “notification of the estimated average per pupil cost for public education in the school division for the coming school year” as well as “actual per pupil state and local education expenditures for the previous school year.”

In addition, Section 22.1-90, *Code of Virginia*, requires that school boards “submit at least once each year to the governing body or bodies appropriating funds to the school board a report of all its expenditures. Such report shall also be made available to the public either on the official school division Web site, or in a hard copy at the central school division office.

Expenditures for Operations include regular day school, school food services, summer school, adult education, athletics, textbooks, and other educational functions; however, it excludes certain expenditures (e.g., facilities, debt service, capital outlay additions, and the pre-kindergarten program.
