Dear Parents or Guardians,

For many kids, summertime means food, friends, and fun. However, for families who count on school breakfast and lunch, the summer months can be stressful and family food budgets have to stretch even further. Free summer meals, funded by the USDA, are available to kids and teens ages 18 and younger at summer meals sites across Virginia.

Sites are also registered with the USDA and are held at safe local places like schools, churches, and community centers.

Our site is located at Amelia County Elementary School at 8533 North Five Forks Road. The Free Summer Meal Program begins Tuesday, June 4 through July 26, 2018. Breakfast and lunch will be available to program participants Monday through Thursdays. Breakfast time is 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and lunch time is 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in the cafeteria at the Elementary School.

Students are welcome to eat breakfast and lunch every day of the program or any day they wish. Students do not need to be enrolled in summer school to take advantage of the meal program. Adults may eat at the site for \$2.00 a meal.

THIS YEAR WE ARE ADDING A FOOD TRUCK/BUS TO THE SERVICE PROVIDED THE YOUTH OF AMELIA COUNTY. THE BUS WILL KEEP THE SAME SCHEDULE AS OUR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SITE, PROVIDING LUNCH FROM 11:00 A.M. TO 1:00 P.M. THE BUS WILL BE MAKING FIVE (5) LUNCH STOPS WHERE KIDS AND TEENS AGES 18 AND UNDER MAY BOARD THE AIR CONDITIONED BUS AND EAT A HEALTHY LUNCH. THE FIVE STOPS AND TIMES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- First Stop is at Mannboro Fire Station at 11:00 a.m.
- Second Stop is at the Camp Grounds at 11:30 a.m.
- Third Stop is at the Mottoax Fire Station at 12:00 Noon
- Fourth Stop is at the Paineville Fire Station at 12:30 p.m.
- Fifth Stop is at the Jetersville Fire Station at 1:00 p.m.

## Free Summer Meal Program Details:

- Meals are **FREE to children and teens ages 18 and younger** who come to a summer meals site
- Food served is **healthy and follows USDA nutrition guidelines**
- No application or proof of income needed. You can just bring your child to our summer meals site in our community
